### **How domestic violence affects women's mental health**

It is now generally recognised that experiencing domestic violence and abuse is associated with mental health problems including anxiety and depression. These issues can make the abusive situation even worse, as the partner or ex-partner may make use a mental health diagnosis (for example, telling someone that they're 'mad').

Some 1.2 million women and 700,000 men experience domestic violence each year, according to the Office for National Statistics. 1 However, these figures relate only for official reports of violence, with the real figure likely to be much higher.
