Ahead of the bank holiday we are taking a look at 'Folk Devils and Moral Panics: The Creation of the Mods and Rockers', written by Stanley Cohen and it is a piece of work highly respected by British criminologists. The book looks at the social and media reaction to the conflict between the Mods and Rockers in the 60's.

### **Folk Devils and Moral Panics: The Creation of the Mods and ...**

Mods and rockers were two conflicting British youth subcultures of the early/mid 1960s to early 1970s. Media coverage of mods and rockers fighting in 1964 sparked a moral panic about British youth, and the two groups became widely perceived as violent, unruly troublemakers.. The rocker subculture was centred on motorcycling, and their appearance reflected that.

Every successive generation since World War II seemed gripped by such "moral panic", with the Rockers and Mods being one of the earliest, succeeded in later years by hippies, punks, skinheads, chavs, and so on. With each subsequent youth culture, many adults felt it was a sign of society's moral decay and a slow slide into anarchy.

### **FOLK DEVILS AND MORAL PANICS: THE CREATION OF THE MODS AND ...**

Stanley Cohen's study of Mods and Rockers in the 1960s was a foundational text both in terms of investigating the workings of subcultural groups and identifying the concept of a 'moral panic' generated by the media, which leads to groups being vilified in the popular imagination, and inhibits rational debate about solutions to the social problems such groups represent.

### **Folk Devils and Moral Panics: The Creation of the Mods and ...**

Cohen argued that when the media reports on deviant behaviour they construct a narrative which features a clear villain: the folk devil. In his study, the folk devils were the violent youth subcultures, "mods and rockers". The creation of folk devils can kickstart a moral panic. Moral Panics

Mods and Rockers, skinheads, video nasties, designer drugs, bogus asylum seekers and hoodies. Every era has its own moral panics. It was Stanley Cohen's classic account, first published in the early 1970s and regularly revised, that brought the term 'moral panic' into widespread discussion.

By 1965, the Mods and Rockers were firmly defined in the English mind as a true scourge (Cohen, 1972). They were "folk devils", figures who incite fear based on a lack of understanding; a moral panic had begun. Cohen believed that certain elements needed to be present for a moral panic to take hold.

Firstly, Cohen can be seen to rather neglect the idea that labels and identities are negotiated, since he tends to portray the mods and rockers as the victims of public reaction to the media and to moral panics. This glosses over the fact that not all members of the public may react in the way he supposes, and condemn the mods and rockers.
